

DODGE RAM DUALY – WITHOUT FENDER FLARES REAR MUD GUARD - INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Please read instructions thoroughly before installation.

Tools Required

- Short Phillips screwdriver
- Marking Utensil
- Drill / 1/8" drill bit

Package Contents

- Driver & Passenger Side Rear Mud Guards
- #10 SEM Screws (qty. 6)
- Medium U-Clip (qty. 4)
- Instruction Sheet

MUD GUARD INSTALLATION

NOTE: It may be necessary to remove the wheels before mud guard installation.

1. Remove the existing fasteners from locations A and B (Figure 1).
2. Attach the mud guard at locations A and B with the existing fasteners. Check the mud guard fit and appearance before tightening.
3. Using the mud guard as a template, mark and drill 1/8" holes at locations C, D, and E.
4. Install a #10 SEM Screw at location C.
5. Install a #10 SEM Screw at locations D and E, thru the fender liner into a U-Clip on the backside of the fender liner. NOTE: The U-Clip does not clip over the fender liner.



PAINTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Clean mud guard with soap and water to remove dirt and other contaminants.
2. Sand painting surface with 320 grit sand paper.
3. Apply a coating of flexible primer-adhesion promoter.
4. Apply a flexible paint as directed by the paint manufacturer.
